Program - Nancy P gave a wonderful **program** on one block wonders. First thing, find a fabric that has lots of color and not a lot of background. Fabric must have a repeating pattern. The ideal would be a 24-inch repeat, but Nancy P was an 8-inch repeat which she doubled to 16 inches, and it looked wonderful. Use 6 layers of fabric where the repeat is lined up using pins. Pinning together 6 layers is somewhat tedious but necessary. Cut fabric into 3 and ³/₄" strips. Use a 60-degree ruler to make triangles that become hexagons by putting the same point in the center for the matching triangles. You have three choices for hexagons with each type of triangle. Sew in rows with half hexagons. Design wall is almost an imperative. To try out a fabric to see what will happen check out Oneblockwonder.com/design-helper/ or get a foldable mirror.
