Program (Sandy O. and Charlie W.)

Video about the "magic" of creating interesting blocks by cutting and "disappearing" some basic blocks. Video is posted on the Chequamegon Bay Quilters web page. Sandy played the magician (in black with wand) and Charlie was the assistant (in white) who cut the disappearing blocks. They used a design wall to show the original block and the "magically created" new block. Disappearing 4-patch, 9 patch, hourglass, and four versions of pinwheel (swap, flop, flip, and spin). All the blocks used 5" squares (such as would be found in a charm pack) to start. The idea was adapted from the May-June 2020 issue of *Love of Quilting*.
